Re: MTM Conflict-Free Tungsten Sourcing Policy

Mi-Tech Metals, Inc. (MTM) is a privately held manufacturer of Tungsten Heavy Alloy articles and Tungsten Composites. MTM is fully committed to the responsible sourcing of conflict minerals in accordance with Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act. Additionally, MTM believes there is a social responsibility to be adhered to as a supplier of tungsten containing products. MTM condemns all activities that may finance or benefit armed groups in the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and surrounding countries.

Mi-Tech Metals is not a publicly traded company and is not subject to reporting compliance to the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission per Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Act. We are however, prepared to assist our customers in their efforts to comply with the conflict minerals rules adopted by the SEC. MTM works closely with our raw material suppliers to ensure the material we are sourcing does not originate from the conflict zone.

MTM's conflict-free sourcing policies include:

- Sourcing powders from responsible suppliers and smelters who are compliant with Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Act.
- Re-processing internal tungsten-containing by-product (re-cycled material).
- Sourcing powders from suppliers who are participating in third party audits under the Conflict Free Sourcing Initiative (CFSI) jointly developed with the TI-CMC and the Electronic Industry Citizenship Coalition (EICC).
- Supporter Member of the Tungsten Industry – Conflict Minerals Council (TI-CMC).
- Adhere to the framework of the TI-CMC and the EICC.
